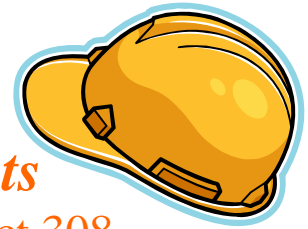

Fox Chase Elementary

Project: New addition to serve increased student enrollment.

Timeline: Began in November 2008

Anticipated completion date of August 2009

Status:

- Installed the interior structural steel
- Completing the roofing insulation and shingles.
- Installing the metal stud framing for the classroom areas.

Homestead Elementary

Project: New addition to serve increased student enrollment.

Timeline: Began in November 2008

Anticipated completion date of August 2009

Status:

- Installing the interior block walls
- Installing the exterior brick veneer

Lakewood Creek Elementary

Project: New addition to serve increased student enrollment.

Timeline: Began in November 2008

Anticipated completion date of August 2009

Status:

- Completed exterior brick veneer
- Completed the concrete floor
- Completed the interior masonry walls



On-going Construction

Long Beach Elementary

Project: Renovation and a building addition to provide functional equity with newer district elementary schools.

Timeline: Construction to begin June 2009
Anticipated completion date of August 2009

Status:

- New roof installed over the 1973 classroom wing
- HVAC rough-in is continuing
- New electric service has been installed

On-going Construction

Oswego High School

Project: Renovation and an addition to provide functional equity between the district high schools.

Timeline: Began in June 2008

Anticipated completion date of August 2010

Status:

- Currently in Phase II of the project
- Moved tennis courts to an east field. Previous tennis court space to be used as a new school main entry and expanded parking area
- New bus/staff driveway was constructed along Route 71 (previous marching band practice field). Working on alignment with Franklin Street. Expected to be completed for use next school year.
- Work continues on the classroom addition on the west side of Oswego High School along Route 71
 - Masonry contractor completed installing the exterior brick veneer
 - Installation of the lay-in ceiling has begun
 - Drywall contractor has completed installation and the interior walls are ready to be painted



On-going Construction

Thompson Junior High School

Project: Renovations and two additions to increase enrollment to 1,125 and provide functional equity with other district junior high schools.

Timeline: Phase III began in June 2008/
Anticipated completion date of July 2009

Phase IV began in June 2009/
Anticipated completion date of August 2009

Status:

- Completed the two new art rooms, learning resource center, and main office
- Existing classroom renovation has begun
- Carpet and vinyl flooring installation complete in classroom areas
- Mechanical piping complete in the boiler and chiller rooms

Completed Projects

Boulder Hill Elementary School

Project: Renovation and a building addition to provide functional equity with newer district elementary schools.

Timeline: Phase I began in April 2007 / Completed in November 2007
Phase II began in June 2007/ Completed in August 2007
Phase III began in June 2008/ Completed in August 2008

Results:

- Major renovations to the existing building including, new paint and carpeting throughout
- 7 new classrooms
- A new gymnasium
- Additional student washrooms
- Additional storage space

Southbury Elementary School

Project: New elementary school built to serve the district's growth in student enrollment.

Timeline: Began in April 2007
Completed in July 2008

Results:

- An elementary school built to serve a student enrollment of 750
- A partnership with the Oswegoland Park District. The park district donated the 10.3 acres of land to the district in exchange for the construction of a park district wing on the building

The Wheatlands Elementary School

Project: New addition to serve increased student enrollment.

Timeline: Began in December 2007
Completed in August 2008

Results:

- 6 additional classrooms
- 3 small classrooms for small group learning
- Additional student washrooms

- A flexible teaching and learning area
- Additional storage space

Traugber Junior High School

Project: New junior high school built to provide functional equity with newer district junior high schools.

Timeline: Began in April 2007
Completed in July 2008

Results:

- A junior high building built to serve a student enrollment of 1,125
- A new building to replace the previous Traugber Junior High School on Franklin Street in order to provide functional equity between the four junior high schools in the district
